Retention Rate Definition

This metric represents first year retention rates for full-time, first-time (FTFT) Degree/certificate-seeking Cohort.

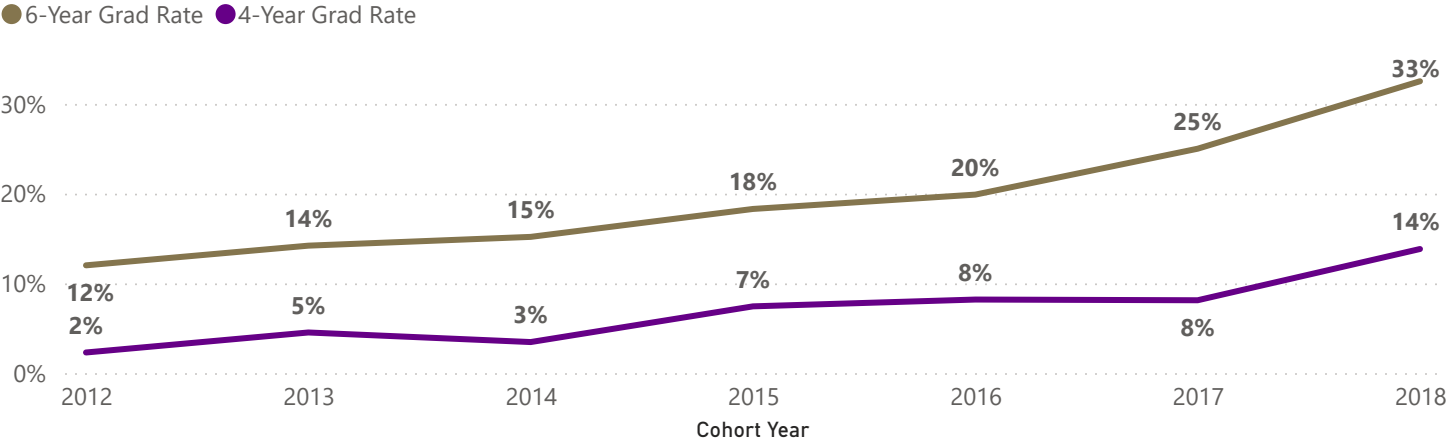
Retention rate is defined as the number of FTFT students that are retained after the first-year, measured on a fall term-to-successive fall term basis (Fall to Fall - October Census Date). **This information is reported on the IPEDS Fall Enrollment Survey**

Cohort Year: Year in which the student enrolled at LOC for the first time

Cohort Size: Original cohort size is adjusted by removing allowable exclusions as defined by IPEDS. Allowable exclusions include death or total permanent disability, leaving for foreign aid service of the federal government (e.g., Peace Corps) and leaving school to serve on an official church mission

Graduation Rate Definition

This metric represents graduation rates for full-time, first-time (FTFT) Bachelor's seeking Cohort. Graduation rates are represented in four- and six-year increments. This shows the percentage of students from the adjusted cohort who graduate within the specified time. **This information is reported on the IPEDS Graduation Rate Survey**

Cohort Year: Year in which the student enrolled at LOC for the first time

Adjusted Cohort: Original cohort size is adjusted by removing allowable exclusions as defined by IPEDS. Allowable exclusions include death or total permanent disability, leaving for foreign aid service of the federal government (e.g., Peace Corps) and leaving school to serve on an official church mission
