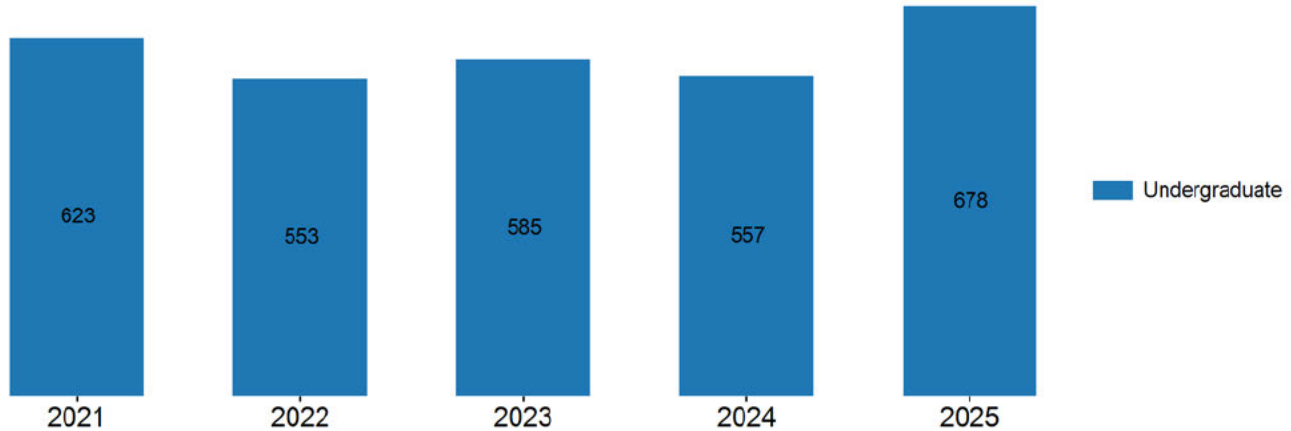

Spring Headcount Enrollment - Five-Year Trend

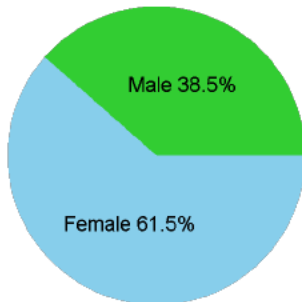

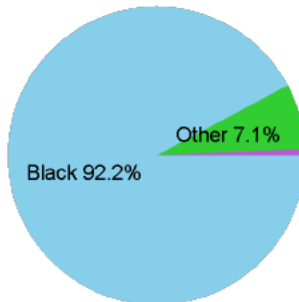

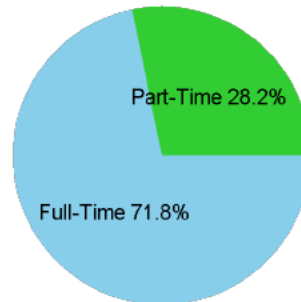
By Gender



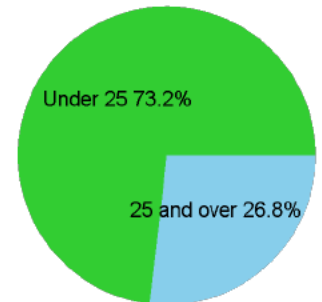
By Race



By Attendance Status

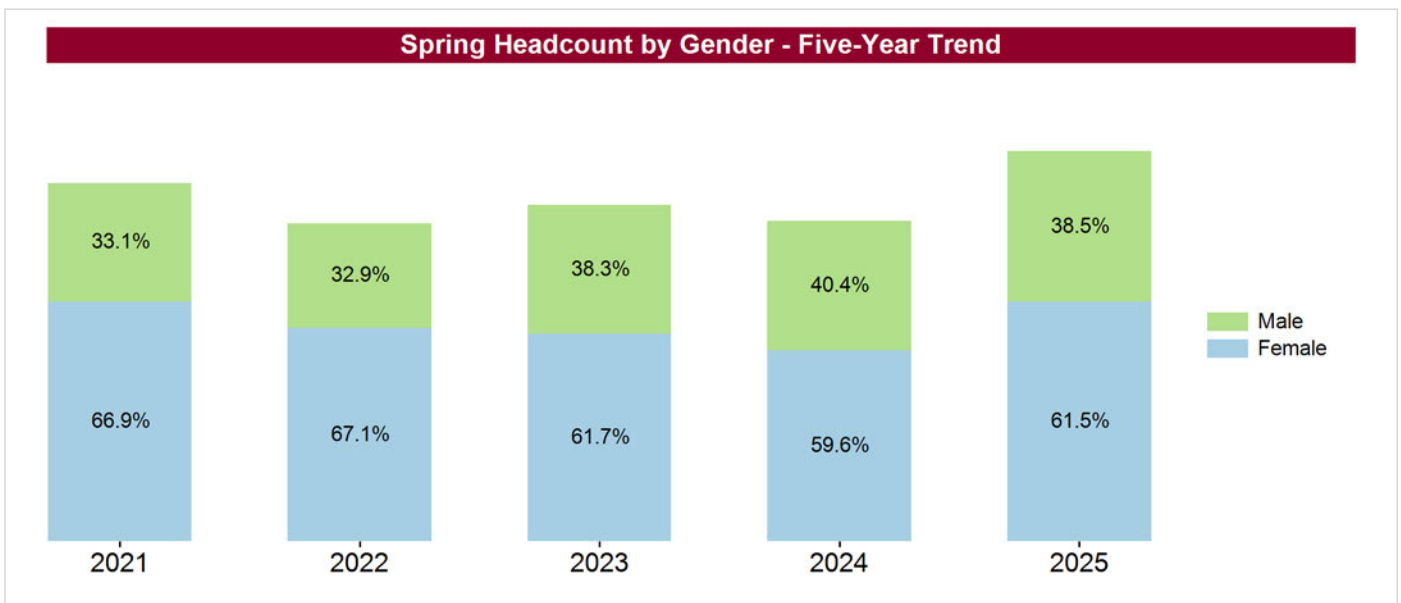

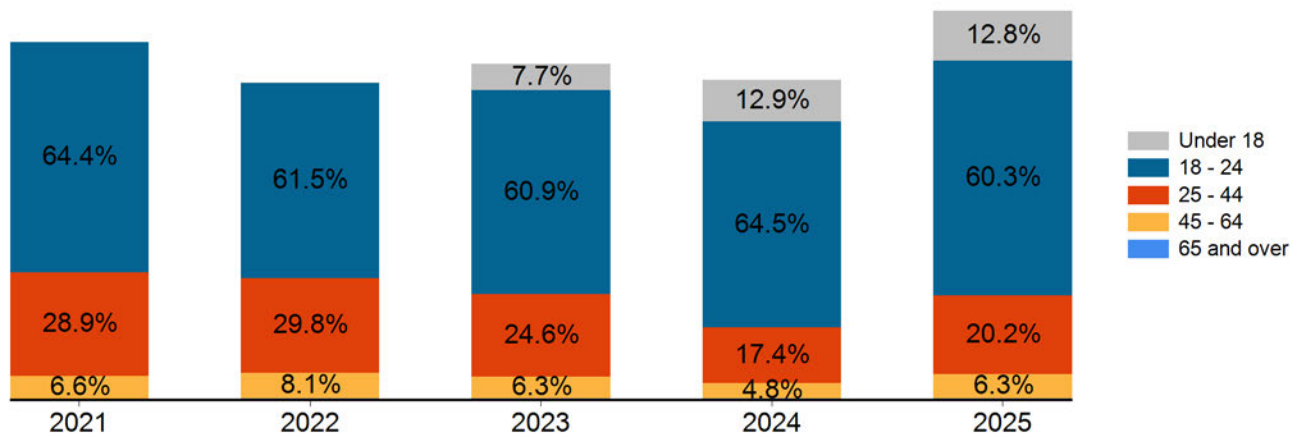

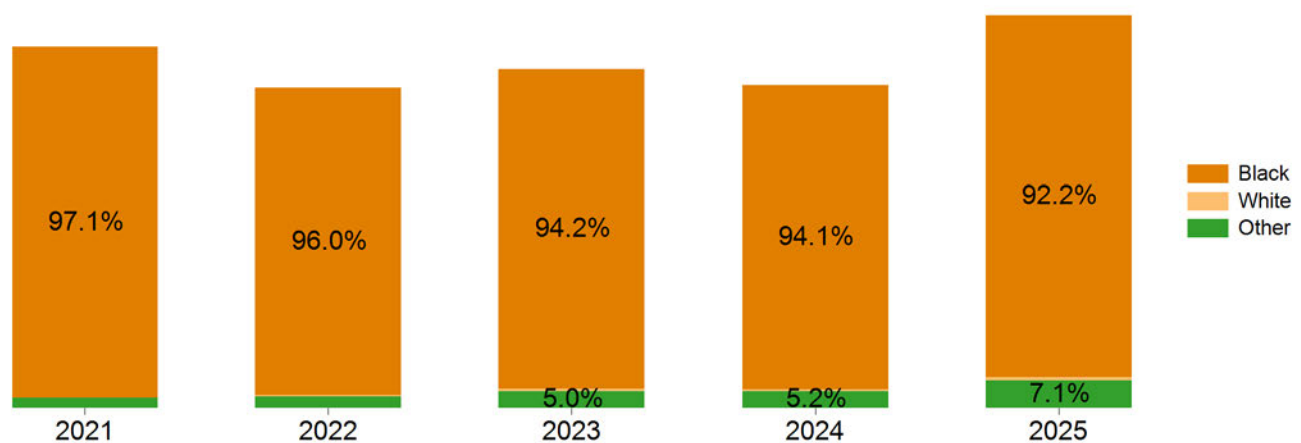

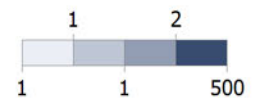

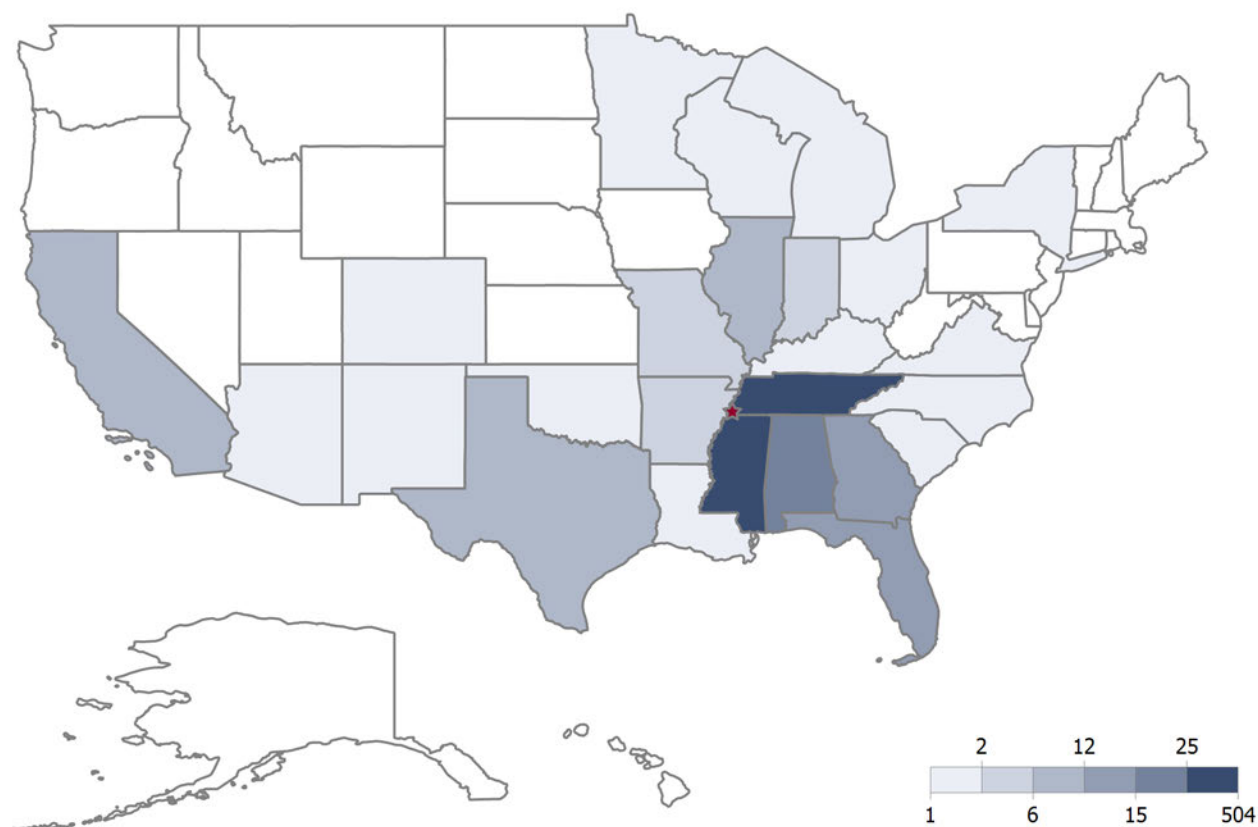
